September 4, 1954 – September 26, 2021

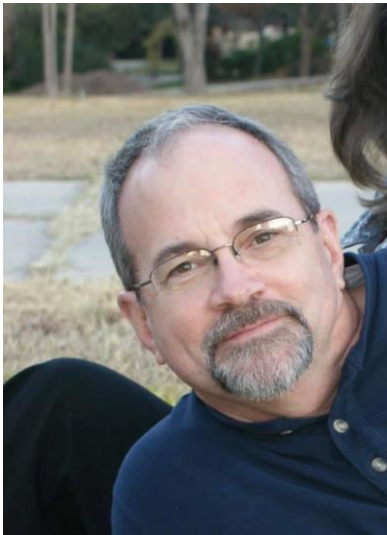


Ray Dickey died on Sunday, September 26, 2021.

He went to the hospital where he was initially monitored and eventually intubated since he couldn't breathe on his own. The pneumonia completely covered his lungs and it wasn't looking good. I went and saw him in the hospital while he was under sedation while intubated. That was the hardest experience of my life. But I'm glad I did, because I got to kiss him, tell him how much I love him, and awkwardly hug him one last time.
